KINEWELLKANTER Sunday 14th January – a walk near the River Nene. Meet at Whitefriars Primary School, Boughton Drive, Rushden, NN10 9HX from 9.30am to leave by 9.45am, or in the car park at Kinewell Lake on the western edge of Ringstead - in time to leave at 10.30 with the option of having a snack afterwards at the nearby Watermill Tea Rooms (www.watermilltearooms.co.uk) at NN14 4DU.

GOING BEYOND BROMSWOLD: Sunday 11th February – a walk in the countryside between Newton Bromswold and Yelden. Meet at Whitefriars from 9.45 for a 10am departure, or park on the grassed area on the road that passes Newton Bromswold just before it swings left and goes downhill downwards Chelveston – in time to start at 10.30. Newton Bromswold Memorial Hall nearby is at NN10 OSP.

LOOPING ROUND THE LAKES: Sunday 11th March - a walk in the countryside at the edge of the Stanwick Lakes. Meet at Whitefriars at 9.45 for a 10am departure, or at the Stanwick Lakes car park (NN9 6GY) by 10.30. Parking is likely to cost £2.50 per car according to www.stanwicklakes.org.uk/visit/parking/

Also, 'BEATING THE BOUNDS' on the 10th anniversary of the creation of the Whitefriars Church of England Parish in Rushden – walking about three miles around most of the northern part of the parish, near Higham Ferrers – from 9 Parsonage Way, NN10 0GQ at 10.30am on **Monday 1st January**.
