PRAYER DIARY - March 2018

1	Pray for Sara Owst as she continues in the early stages of her new role as ministry resources manager. Pray that the role will be a place for her to flourish and serve. Give thanks for her offering and many skills.
2	As Retireds' group gathers today, pray for protection over the older members of our church family. We continue to pray that connections will be made between the silver service, Retireds' group and regular Sunday worship.
3	Pray for the Bishop's Bible day that is taking place today. Lift up Bishop Donald and Bishop John, ask that God would continue to guide and inspire them.
4	Pray for the provision of a venue that is big enough as 'The Well' continues to grow.
5	Pray for the parents who drop-in to the bridge on Monday mornings. Pray that God would establish a firm community of support, love and encouragement.
6	Today please pray for 'Fruit' youth group. We are continuing to share God's word with a group that have little or no contact with church. Pray that the team can be equipped to share their faith and build relationships.
7	Pray for the Lent Lunches which are taking place. As churches come together to eat and pray, ask that God will fill the room with his spirit of peace and unity.
8	Pray for 'The Well' and especially their relationship with the 'King Eddie Pub'. Pray for the pub landlords Nick and Laura, and that the community can become closer friends with them and use the pub for social meetings.

11	Pray for mothers today. Those who have biological children and those who are a maternal figure to others. Ask God to empower mothers to share their faith and have the strength to care for others.
12	Pray for our youth leaders today. As a couple of them attend a training course on youth work tonight, pray that they can continue to learn how to serve and connect to our young people. Pray for provision in a time of stretched rotas.
13	Say the Lords prayer today. Take time on each line to reflect on the words and let them become your motivation for your daily actions.
14	Pray for the 'Solihull' parenting course that Sarah and Julie are running in our community. We pray that God will support and bless all the parents attending.
15	Pray that the new people in 'The Well' will feel at home and be open to going deeper with God.
16	Pray for Chris today. Pray that he can wear the many hats required for his position. Continue to pray for his wellbeing and times of rest.

17	Please pray for Julie and for the new families that she is working with. Pray that she is able to provide the support they need and that some may be introduced to Jesus.
18	Pray for LEGO today as they join other teenagers in Oundle to worship and learn more about God. Pray that they can feel at home among other believers.
19	Please pray for the Sunday Salon which met yesterday. We are praying that we will have even more women from the community come to the salon and engage with church. Pray for Imogen and her team as they offer up their service.
20	Pray for the children in our church who are in school years 1-5 and are part of the Energize group on Sundays. We pray that their faith can become an adventure and a place of certainty and warmth in their life.
21	Pray for Chad, Liz, Phil and Richard as the lead 'The Well'.
22	We pray for those that are crying out for help in our town today, those who are asking for help and find themselves in desperation. Would God continue to break through and amaze people.
23	Try eating a meal in silence today. Ask God to speak to you in this time of eating your daily bread.
24	Pray for The Bridge today. We are blessed to have a little space where we can meet and store our resources. In your prayers please lift up the maintenance of the bridge and thank god for his provision. We also pray that it would become more well known in our local area and continue to house community.
25	Please pray for the older teen group known as 'The Way' which meets weekly to engage in Jesus' teaching and way of life. Pray that our church can support young people as they reach the difficult phase of becoming a young adult.
26	As the church meets this evening to look at missional giving and review who will support this year, please pray for wisdom and direction. That the group will be able to sense where needs support and how we can bless them.
27	Pray for the Pastoral care team which serves our Church. Today please pray for our 'home visiting'. Pray that we can care for one another in our most intimate spaces. Would God open up people's homes to the team as they visit.
28	Come and join others in prayer tonight at the Bridge 7:45pm.
