

Countryside Walks April to June 2018



Like short walks? Want to meet new people? Need a bit of exercise?

Every month, Whitefriars Church, Rushden, organizes short local countryside walks (of about four miles) that are open to people of all ages and fitness levels, whether alone, or as part of a couple or a family. Here are details of our next events...

A RISELEY RECONNOITRE: Sunday 8th April – a walk in countryside south of Riseley. Meet at Whitefriars Primary School, Boughton Drive, Rushden, NN10 9HX from 9.30am to leave by 9.45am, or in the High Street in Riseley near DNS Stores (number 91 High Street) and the junction with the road to Keysoe (MK44 1DD) in time to leave at 10.30.

A KIMBOLTON CORNUCOPIA: Sunday 13th May – a walk on paths in and around Kimbolton. Meet at Whitefriars from 9.30 for a 9.45am departure, or in the wide street in the middle of Kimbolton (the High Street), near the entrance to Kimbolton School (**PE28 0EA**) in time to start at 10.30.

THE SALCEY SHUFFLE: Sunday 10th June - a walk mostly in the woods of Salcey Forest. Meet at Whitefriars at 9.30 for a 9.45am departure, or at the main Salcey Forest car park (NN7 2HX) in time to leave at 10.30. Parking is costs £1.50 per hour or £4 for the day, according to <https://www.forestry.gov.uk/forestry/infd-8bkmju>.

Also, **'BEATING THE BOUNDS Part 2'** in the 10th anniversary year of the creation of the Whitefriars Church of England Parish in Rushden – walking about three miles around the edge of the southern part of the parish – from Whitefriars Primary School, NN10 9HX at 2pm on Saturday 24th March.
